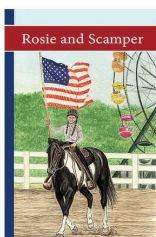
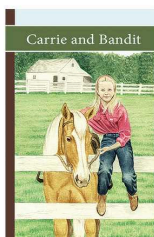

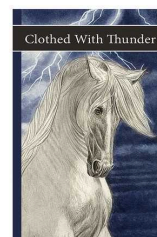
1. Rosie and Scamper

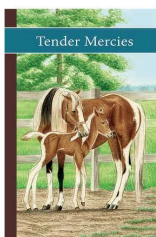
2. Carrie and Bandit

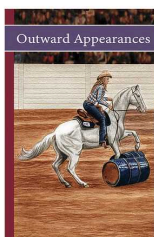
3. Clothed With Thunder

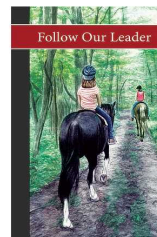
4. Tender Mercies

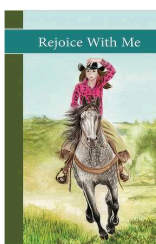
5. Outward Appearances

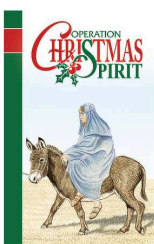

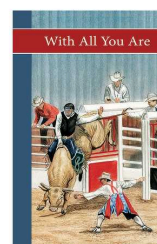
7. Rejoice With Me

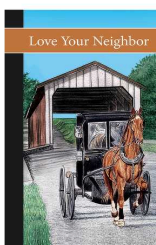
8. Operation Christmas Spirit

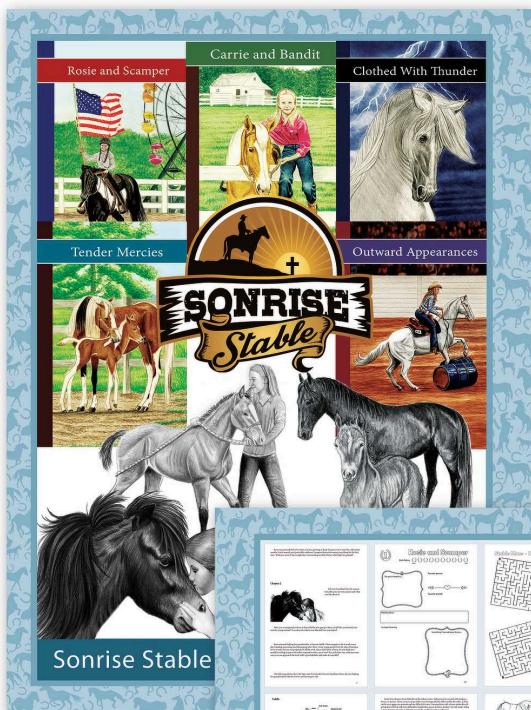

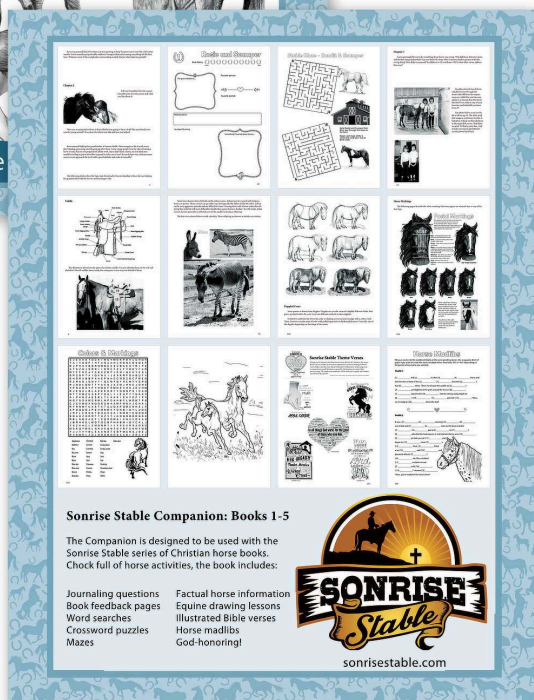
